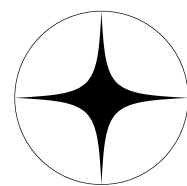

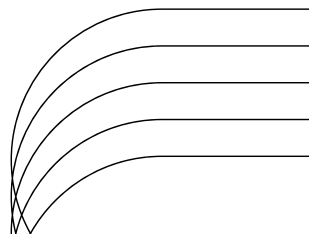

Limited Travel:

The Limited Travel Program is perfect for those athletes who are ready to be introduced to the competitive nature of All Star Cheerleading. The focus is on excellence in skill building, team work, and preparing athletes for FCA's Full Travel competitive program by competing at three competitions per season.

TIMES PER WEEK (1.5/2 HRS EACH)

ALL NON & LIMITED TRAVEL TEAMS WILL HAVE TEAM
PRACTICE ONE TIME PER WEEK (1 / 1.5 HRS)

Videotaping at FCA is prohibited. Any recorded footage
of routines or portions of routines is forbidden to be
posted on any social media. There will be private
groups made for videos to be shared with family
members.

Cheerleading is a unique and demanding sport that
requires coaches to be working closely with the
athletes and therefore little time is available between
practices and classes. If you have questions or want to
speak to a coach, please email the gym to set up a
meeting time with management.

Practices may be added or extended once competition
season starts to ensure the teams are ready to

discretion of the coaches and will be communicated as





RULES AND REGULATIONS CONTRACT

Policy to address Bullying

Bullying of any kind is unacceptable at Forgotten Coast Athletics (FCA) and will not be tolerated. Bullying is counterproductive to team spirit and can be devastating to a victim. FCA is committed to providing a safe, caring and friendly environment for all athletes. If bullying does occur, all athletes and parents should know that incidents will be dealt with promptly and effectively. Anyone who knows that bullying is happening is expected to tell a coach or owner, Stephanie Petersen.

Communication Policy

At competitions coaches are there to coach. Any issues that arise during a competition will be addressed promptly during the week following the competition. Parents should never approach a coach with an issue at competitions.

Please contact the owner, Stephanie Petersen, and a meeting will be scheduled to deal with the issue. Any verbal communications at the gym should be held in private and coaches will only discuss concerns regarding your athlete.

If you or your athlete would like a better understanding of routine placements, team decisions, etc., please email Stephanie. We will set up a meeting with you, your athlete, Stephanie, and the athlete's coach. FCA keeps an open-door policy with communication and will attempt to help each parent and athlete understand every decision in which they are involved.

It is inappropriate for an athlete or parent to approach other FCA members or parents about a problem they have with an FCA coach, a coaching decision, or a disagreement with an administrative decision. This leads to unnecessary drama and may result in immediate dismissal from the team.

We strongly encourage parents to have their athletes speak with the coaches directly:

- 1. Routine element questions**
- 2. Individual skill preparedness**
- 3. Group skill preparedness**
- 4. Injury**
- 5. Illness**

During practices, coaches are needed to coach and instruct the team. Parents should never approach a coach during class or practice. Any issues that arise during a class or practice will be discussed at the end of practice. If an issue is urgent, please notify Stephanie immediately.

While in the gym, verbal communication regarding other athletes, parents, classes, etc., should be held in private. A meeting can be scheduled with the athlete's coach and Stephanie.

We have a strict policy in place stating that Coaches are not available to discuss:

- 1. Information regarding other FCA athletes and/or parents.**
- 2. FCA Coaches who do not coach their athlete.**
- 3. Decisions made by the Administrative Staff.**
- 4. Issues that involve any type of comparison of their athlete with another athlete in the program**

Athletes are expected to:

- Treat fellow teammates, coaches, staff, and parent with respect at all times.**
- Not participate in gossip.**
- Show good sportsmanship at ALL times.**
- Not bully. This includes all forms such as electronic, verbal, physical, mental, social media based, monetary, etc.**
- Not use profanity and/or abusive language.**
- Not consume alcoholic beverages, use any illegal drug, and/or engage in illegal behaviors. •Accept both constructive criticisms along with praise for a job well done.**



PARENT EXPECTATIONS

At FCA, we strive to maintain a respectful, positive, and team-centered environment. To support this goal, we ask that all parents uphold the following expectations:

- **Promote Respect:** Encourage your athlete to consistently show respect to teammates, coaches, and staff.
- **Let Coaches Coach:** Please refrain from giving instructions or feedback to your athlete during practice from the parent-viewing area or lobby.
- **Trust the Coaches:** Respect and support the decisions made by coaches regarding the team and athletes.
- **Avoid Practice Withholding as Punishment:** Do not withhold your child from practice or competitions as a form of discipline. This impacts not only your athlete but also their teammates and coaches.
- **Commitment Matters:** Threats to withdraw your child from the team are unacceptable and will not be tolerated.
- **No Gossip Policy:** Avoid participating in or spreading gossip. This includes initiating or listening to negative talk about athletes, families, or staff.
- **Respectful Conduct:** Do not attempt to influence or manipulate other parents or athletes during practices or events.
- **Use Social Media Responsibly:** Never use social media, messaging platforms, or any digital communication to share negative or inappropriate content related to FCA, its athletes, or families. Doing so may result in immediate dismissal from the program.
- **Viewing Area Guidelines:** The parent-viewing area is generally open for observation. However, the staff reserves the right to restrict access if necessary for the benefit of the athletes and coaches. (NEW GYM ONLY)

Our gym culture does not tolerate parent drama.

The Cheer Parents' CARDINAL RULE:

NEVER speak negatively about another athlete — EVER. Focus on encouraging your own athlete and uplifting the team.

QUITTING AND NON-COMPETE POLICY

Quitting Policy

Your Account will be charged \$500.00 for QUITTING on top of the monthly tuition. Due to the best interest of the other athletes, any athlete that is dismissed from a team or voluntarily decides to quit after the JUNE 23 2026 will be responsible for the remaining months of outstanding payments as detailed in the "Monthly Financial Obligation" Section. Please consider the time and the requirements it takes to be an all-star cheerleader BEFORE enrolling in the program.



If for any reason, circumstances occur, which require departure from the program; we do not expect any refund of fees or competition expenses and understand that we may not participate in another All-Star Gym within a 75 mile radius until the following season (2026-2027)

I understand that if my child quits or is asked to leave the program, i am not allowed to participate in another All-Star Program within 75 miles from Forgotten Coast Athletics . I understand that if my child does participate in another All-Star Program, Forgotten Coast Athletics can pursue legal action.
