As an All-Star gym, we are required to follow these guidelines, however, OPEN rules can change at any time. These guidelines will help us build our teams and gym not only for this season, but for years to come. Team placements are up to the discretion of the coaches and management.

PRACTICES

ALL ELITE TEAMS WILL HAVE TEAM PRACTICE TWO TIMES PER WEEK (2 HRS EACH)

ALL PREP TEAMS WILL HAVE TEAM PRACTICE ONE TIME PER WEEK (2 HRS)

Practices may be added or extended once competition season starts to ensure the teams are ready to compete at the highest level. This is up to the discretion of the coaches and will be communicated as best as possible. ____Initial

Athletes should plan to arrive at least 10 minutes early and be ready to go at the start of practice. Athletes should be in practice clothing, with shoes on, and hair up. Initial

Videotaping at FCA is prohibited. Any recorded footage of routines or portions of routines is forbidden to be posted on any social media. There will be private groups made for videos to be shared with family members.

Cheerleading is a unique and demanding sport that requires coaches to be working closely with the athletes and therefore little time is available between practices and classes. If you have questions or want to speak to a coach, please email the gym to set up a meeting time with management.

"Black-Out Week" is the week prior to a Competition. Practice can be added that week. All Practices during "Black-Out Week" MUST be attended – NO EXCEPTIONS ____Initial

CHOREOGRAPHY CAMP

Choreography camp is a required event. The dates are mandatory as the entire team needs to be at practice during the choreography camp dates. Choreography camp practices will be 4-5 hours long.

Removal from Competition Team. If an athlete is removed from a Competition Team, the remainder of that year's monthly payments are still due each month.

All-star Competitive Cheerleading Requires a Financial Commitment, and it is Very Important You Read and Understand All Obligations.

Forgotten Coast Athletics Wants to do our Best to Make this as Affordable as Possible.

- * Monthly Payments are Due the 1st of the Month. If Payment is Not Received by the 5th, a late charge of \$15 Will Be Added to the Cheerleader's Account
- *All Cheerleaders **MUST** be enrolled in our Auto-Draft Program (GOMOTION)
- * All Members Must Provide a Void Check and Auto Debit Authorization Form In Addition to the Registration Form at Team Placements(GOMOTION SYSTEM)
- *Monthly Payment Commitment is from June Through April. (11 months)
- *First Month Payments Due at Try-Outs June 3, 2023
- *All Declined Auto-Draft Payments Will Have A \$35 Charge Added to the Cheerleader's Account
- * All Monthly Payments Must be Current Before an Athlete May Compete, Practice, Or Participate in Private Lessons.
- *Private Lessons are Available with the Coaches. All Private Lesson Payments will be Paid to FCA. Private Lessons are \$25 Per Half-Hour or \$40 Per Full Hour Lesson.
- *Holidays and the School Calendar are Factored into the Monthly Payment Calculations. No Refunds or Makeup Practices Will Be Offered, However, Additional Practices Can Be Added at Any Time at the Discretion of the Coaches and Management.

RULES AND REGULATIONS CONTRACT

Policy to address Bullying

Bullying of any kind is unacceptable at Forgotten Coast Athletics (FCA) and will not be tolerated. Bullying is counterproductive to team spirit and can be devastating to a victim. FCA is committed to providing a safe, caring and friendly environment for all athletes. If bullying does occur, all athletes and parents should know that incidents will be dealt with promptly and effectively. Anyone who knows that bullying is happening is expected to tell a coach or owner, Stephanie Petersen.

Communication Policy

At competitions coaches are there to coach. Any issues that arise during a competition will be addressed promptly during the week following the competition. Parents should never approach a coach with an issue at competitions.

Please contact the owner, Stephanie Petersen, and a meeting will be scheduled to deal with the issue. Any verbal communications at the gym should be held in private and coaches will only discuss concerns regarding your athlete.

If you or your athlete would like a better understanding of routine placements, team decisions, etc., please email Stephanie. We will set up a meeting with you, your athlete, Stephanie, and the athlete's coach. FCA keeps an open-door policy with communication and will attempt to help each parent and athlete understand every decision in which they are involved.

It is inappropriate for an athlete or parent to approach other FCA members or parents about a problem they have with an FCA coach, a coaching decision, or a disagreement with an administrative decision. This leads to unnecessary drama and may result in immediate dismissal from the team.

We strongly encourage parents to have their athletes speak with the coaches directly:

- 1. Routine element questions
- 2. Individual skill preparedness
- 3. Group skill preparedness
- 4. Injury
- 5. Illness

During practices, coaches are needed to coach and instruct the team. Parents should never approach a coach during class or practice. Any issues that arise during a class or practice will be discussed at the end of practice. If an issue is urgent, please notify Stephanie immediately.

While in the gym, verbal communication regarding other athletes, parents, classes, etc., should be held in private. A meeting can be scheduled with the athlete's coach and Stephanie.

We have a strict policy in place stating that Coaches are not available to discuss:

- 1. Information regarding other FCA athletes and/or parents.
- 2. FCA Coaches who do not coach their athlete.
- 3. Decisions made by the Administrative Staff.
- 4. Issues that involve any type of comparison of their athlete with another athlete in the program

Athletes are expected to:

- •Treat fellow teammates, coaches, staff, and parent with respect at all times.
- •Not participate in gossip.
- •Show good sportsmanship at ALL times.
- •Not bully. This includes all forms such as electronic, verbal, physical, mental, social media based, monetary, etc.
- •Not use profanity and/or abusive language.
- •Not consume alcoholic beverages, use any illegal drug, and/or engage in illegal behaviors.
- •Accept both constructive criticisms along with praise for a job well done.

Quitting Policy: Your Account will be charged \$500.00 for QUITING on top of the monthly tuition.

We have familiarized ourselves with the contents of this "Rules and Regulations Contract". We acknowledge, understand, accept, and agree to comply with the program guidelines. We understand this document cannot cover every situation that could arise during the season, but is a guide to the goals, rules and responsibilities as a member of Forgotten Coast Athletics. We understand that this signed Contract will be maintained and in force for the entire 2023-2024 season.
